

Parish Council Report for 2nd July 2026

Safer Roads & Honeybourne Crossroads/ Sub Committee

- Following several email requests and escalating matters to Cllr Roger Whyborn, a meeting is scheduled on 14th July at 11.30 am @ The Seagrave to discuss speed in general through the village and at Honeybourne/Weston Crossroads to determine what can be done. Rhodri Grey will be representing the Highways Department, but I note he has invited a number of his senior colleagues to join electronically. I have also been advised that Rhodri may be able to assist us with CIL monies.
- Tom Bradley, together with local business representatives, will be in attendance. All Councillors welcome.
- The email trail with Cllr. Whyborn and his response were sent to you on 23rd June. He needs to prioritise, and pursuing speed data may help us.
- The Parish Council has access to speed camera data, and we need to trawl through the historic data and determine if we have a strong enough case for the Safer Roads 20mph scheme. The handheld mobile device will also assist with any records held by Mike Jelley.
- Richard and I shall review what we have in terms of data in readiness for the meeting on 14th July
- I've approached the Police regarding a speed camera vehicle visiting the village; they are meeting me on 8th July to discuss and determine a plan of action. I am very reassured by their response and eagerness to engage.
- Speed signs on Dover's Hill are now repaired, unsure about the issue at Red Brick Cottages.

Action : - prepare report with Richard Court, Mike Jelley and the police speed team.

Engaging the community in capturing speed – I put out a request, and we have at least 18 volunteers. Meeting with the police to determine if they can run some courses for us, in the short term, Mike will train another villager and me.

Action: RC/HM to establish and review data already on records and chase up on training for villagers .

Green Spaces

Nothing to report, response due by the end of July.

Action – HM chase end of July

CPR Awareness Training

Received a positive response on this from the South Western Ambulance Service, and they will happily run a session for us . I shall advertise once I have a firm date. Unfortunately, they are not able to support the forthcoming Village Fete on 12th July.
